Yet at the right time, the woman was immediately *"healed of her disease,"* and the little girl *"got up and began walking"* (Mark 5:29, 42). Such is *"the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ,"* who humbled Himself unto the extreme poverty of death *"so that you by his poverty might become rich,"* even unto life everlasting (2 Cor. 8:9).
